

Laser Treatment

Patient instructions

Before the procedure:

- It's recommended to stop smoking a month before the procedure.
- Please reframe from eating or drinking 6 hours before the procedure in case of general anaesthesia.
- 3 days prior to the procedure, it's compulsory to start a <u>treatment for herpes</u> (Acyclovir): 5x
 800mg. We will provide the necessary prescriptions.
- The day of the procedure, it's recommended <u>not to wear make-up</u> or nail polish and to avoid applying day cream.
- The day of the procedure, it's recommended not to wear contact lenses.
- The day of the procedure, it's recommended not to wear <u>jewellery/piercings</u>. We also ask you
 to wear a shirt or sweater with a zipper or with buttons so garments do not need to be pulled
 over the head after the procedure.

After the procedure:

- After the procedure you will be prohibited from driving a vehicle for 24 hours.
- If you experience pain it's recommended to use Dafalgan (paracetamol); take 1 tablet (1g) 4 times daily.
- Also antibiotics (Amoxiclav 875/125mg) needs to be taken 2tabelts a day and this during 10 days.
- Please sleep in semi-seated position and do not place your face, which was treated, on the pillow.
- The day after your laser you will come back for a follow-up.
- The following post-operative days: From then onwards we will give you new appointments for a 2 week period in order to ensure thorough follow-up.
- A sensation of discomfort/skin tightness/itching may occur. It's strictly forbidden to remove the mask or to remove the scabs.
- A 5- day continuation of the herpes (Acyclovir) treatment is compulsory.
- Swelling will be noticeable for about a week but will subsequently fade away.
- You are prohibited from washing your face the first week after the procedure. Our medical team will take it on themselves to wash your face for the first time.
- Prepare liquid meals for the first post-operative days (soups/shakes/puree).
- Avoid sun-exposure the first months after the procedure. For a minimum-period of 1 year, you
 will be required to apply factor-50 sunscreen.
- o It is recommended not to wear makeup for the first 3 weeks after treatment.
- After the operation, you will receive a personalised letter from us with important information that applies specifically to you. These may differ from the guidelines in this letter.

We'd like to see you back for all after care in our Beclinic. A check-up is indicated after 72hours, 14 days and 8-10 weeks after surgery.
